



As you may have noticed we now have a recycle bin for plastics located at the County Road Department in Arbon. Please help our Mother Earth and take advantage of this wonderful container by bringing all of your plastics and recycling them. Especially the twine from your hay bales... No more burning the twine! 😊

There are a few rules to the recycle container though:

1. No containers that have had petroleum products in them.  
(containers that have held petroleum are non-recyclable and can be thrown away.)
2. All plastic containers and twine are accepted.  
(except petroleum)
3. Chemical containers must be properly rinsed out and labels removed.  
(no booklets or labels left on the containers. Containers with imprinted labels are fine, you do not need to scratch off the printing).
4. No Lids, take them off and throw them away.  
(the lids are generally made of a harder plastic and will not shred easy)

I'm pretty sure I don't need to mention... not to put normal garbage in that container. 😊
